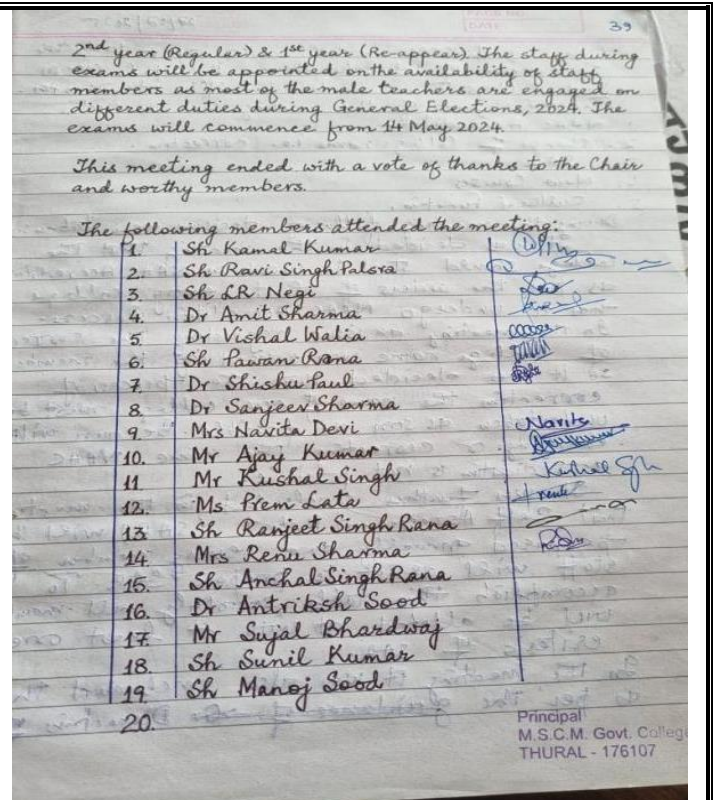
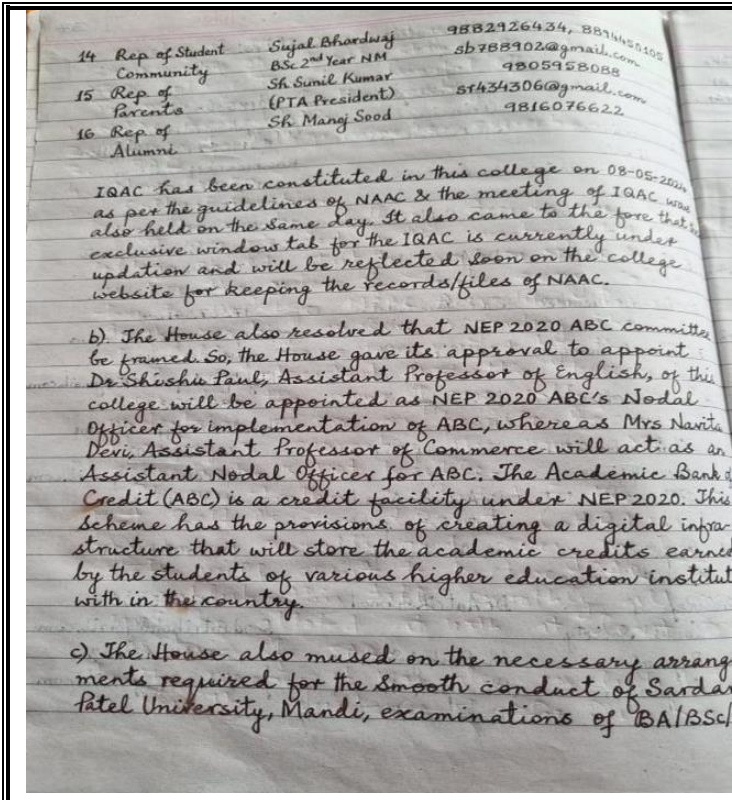
- a) To constitute the IQAC as per the NAAC guidelines
